**IMPORTANT:** Before applying for a Research Visa, the applicant needs to have the approval from the Press & Culture Department. This can be done by sending an email and explaining your activity in India providing supporting document. **NOTE:** If you are going for a research purpose then you may apply under STUDENT VISA CATEGORY.

## LIST OF DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR A RESEARCH VISA

- 1 Original passport valid for a minimum of 6 months (or for the validity requested, if greater) and having  at least 2 blank visa pages
- 2 Two photographs conforming to Indian Government norms as per specifications mentioned on our  website
  - A Photo service complying to the Indian norms is available in our offices
- 3 An Indian Government visa application form duly filled in online and signed on pages 1 and 2 (online  form link: <https://indianvisaonline.gov.in/visa/index.html> )
- 4 Admission/Invitation letter from recognized institution/university in India stating the type of research,  location and duration along with the copy of concerned institution's recognition certificate
- 5 Declaration form : to be filled by all applicants submitting any application
- 6 Additional documents mentioned below as per your case

## LIST OF ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS

### If the applicant is not holding a Spanish passport

- Registration Certificate from the concern City Council/Municipal (minimum period of stay in Spain is 2  years), with an issue date which should not exceed 180 days.
- Referral form duly filled in Capital Letters

### If the applicant obtained Spanish nationality by naturalization and previously held Bangladeshi, Pakistani or Sri Lankan nationality

- Literal Birth certificate. (Certificación literal de nacimiento)
- Nationality certificate proving when Spanish nationality was obtained
